David N. Deutsch is President of David N. Deutsch & Company (established in 1993, an investment banking and board advisory firm providing M&A and strategic financial advisory to leading closely-held companies and their owners); Managing Member of The Presidents Council (a consortium of CEOs, Wall Street executives and family offices that gather quarterly and invest together); and Founder of The Saratoga Weekend (established in 1999, “Camp David,” as it has become known, is a legendary gathering of CEOs, capital providers, professional advisors, journalists, authors, educators, government officials and others for ‘business-and-broader’ discussion).

Mr. Deutsch began his career as a bond trader at Wall Street’s venerable Lehman Brothers Kuhn Loeb and, in banking at Drexel Burnham Lambert and Bear Stearns, worked on some of the most important transactions of the ‘80s and ‘90s. He coined the expression Leveraged Finance; and established one of the first boutique firms nearly 30 years (and 140 assignments) ago. He served on innumerable corporate and non-profit boards (founder of the Wall Street Council of Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts, a founding trustee of the Museum of American Finance (Smithsonian), global board of Earth Day, long-time lead independent director of the Biomedical Research Alliance of NY, among others),

In addition to being recognized on November 15th, Mr. Deutsch also will be inducted into The M&A Advisor’s Hall of Fame during The M&A Advisor’s Signature Awards Gala that evening, a feature of the [2022 Future of Dealmaking Summit](#).
